**PLEASE NOTE:** If you do not have any of these items, I have extras to share. If you have it, and you are able to travel with it, bring it for your own personal use. Please ID your items.

### **YOU BRING:**

- Apron or paint clothes
- Bonefolder (bone or Teflon) – 5" or longer
- Bookbinding Awl OR Pro clay "needle" tool - (straight shaft)
- Metal cork-backed ruler (18" or 24")
- X-Acto knife with extra #11 blades OR Snap-off cutting knife
- PRANG watercolor set
- Micron Pens (01, 05 & 08)
- 3M Sandpaper sponge (or similar brand)
- Sharp scissors (small and/or regular size for trimming)
- 2-6 medium bulldog or binder clamps
- Natural Bristle Chip Brush— 1" & 2" (Home Depot, \$\$-Store, etc.)
- Painter's blue removable tape OR Frog green tape
- Glue stick (1 large) – (UHU brand, if available)
- Sharpened pencil(s) or mechanical pencil
- White and/or black eraser
- Waxed paper
- Cutting mat OR mat board scraps to cut on (18"x 24" or larger)
- Old terrycloth washcloth or dishcloth (to wet for sticky fingers)
- 1 wide-mouthed glass jar with lid (approximately 16 oz)
- Two (2) small plastic grocery bags (for trash clippings)
- Notebook for note-taking

### **\*\*\*OPTIONAL\*\*\* (Not required, but bring if you wish)**

- Beads, buttons, medallions or any 3D decorative/collage elements to add to books
- C-Thru™ ruler (18" or 24") –good for centering
- VERITHIN colored pencils
- Watercolor brushes of various sizes (can be inexpensive)
- Microspatula (8" long) – for detail gluing
- Bookbinding score tool
- Basic calligraphy supplies: Nibs, holders, favorite inks or gouache, to make calligraphic marks to include in/on your project (remember....optional).

**SUPPLY FEE WILL INCLUDE:** Assortment of specialty art papers for pages & covers; Cover boards; binding needles and implements; linen threads & sundries; adhesives; paints, inks, alternative tools; etc.; decorative items; PLUS Several handouts.
