Welcome to your Ghost Ranch Art Experience!

I am so excited to meet each of you and to get you better acquainted with your inner artist! Come prepared for a great time of learning and camaraderie, while working at your own pace to sharpen your artistic skills. It is sure to be a great experience that will shape your heart, mind and soul.

OIL PAINTERS: You will need

- Your oil paints (water miscible is also acceptable)
- Brushes (a couple of different sizes if you have them)
- 3-5 Gessoed canvas (11x14 is a suggested size and quantity based on how quickly you work)
- Turpentine jar and odorless mineral spirits (If you are flying, be sure I know so I can provide it for you)
- Small ruler
- A roll of paper towels
- And anything else you like to use like mediums (linseed oil, alkyd mediums etc)

PASTEL PAINTERS: You will need

- Your pastels. A range of value and hue, varied hardnesses if available.
- 11x14 pastel surface (or larger that you can block out an 11x14 space to work on)
- Whatever surface you are used to, or I use Pastel Premier as my default surface.
- Short bristle, stiff paint brush (doesn't have to be pretty)
- Small ruler
- Sheets of tracing paper large enough to cover finished work and artists tape
- Roll of paper towels
- And anything else you like to use like pastel pencils, sharpener, container to hold pastels in use etc
- I will provide a foam core surface to tape your paper to if you do not have a preferred one to bring
