Welcome to your Ghost Ranch Art Experience!

I am so excited to meet each of you and to get you connected to your inner artist! Come prepared for a great time of learning and camaraderie, while working at your own pace to sharpen your artistic skills. It will be a great experience that will shape your heart, mind and soul.

**MATERIALS LIST:**

Your tripod and pochade box. If you cannot bring your own, there is a limited number of French easels on a first come, first served basis. **YOU WILL NEED TO LET ME KNOW IN ADVANCE.** If you have your own, that would be best as the French easels have little room for pastels.

**PASTELISTS-** bring a wide array of value and color and a few pastel pencils. If you need guidance, please contact me!

**OIL PAINTERS-** bring your paint, brushes, mineral spirits (if you are flying, **LET ME KNOW IN ADVANCE IF YOU NEED ME TO BRING SOLVENT FOR YOU**)

**WATERCOLORISTS-** bring paints, brushes and all the goodies you're accustomed to using.

**EVERYONE :**

1. bring 6 or more surfaces depending on how quickly you work (11x14 is a suggested manageable size)
2. Containers for water, spirits, etc
3. Substrates for mounting your pastel paper or watercolor paper
4. Tape, scissors, tracing paper to cover and protect work for those painting in pastel and W/C
5. Preparation for how you will travel back home with wet paintings, fragile pastels etc.
6. A roll of paper towels and a **BAG FOR YOUR TRASH** when out painting
7. Wet wipes if you use them

**BRING YOUR CAMERA!**

If you use a mobile phone to take photos, I suggest downloading the **FREE** Photoshop Express App from the App Store. I use it routinely to crop images in the field as a tool to decide my compositions. While this isn't necessary, it is recommended. Please do this ahead of time as internet access here is not very reliable.
